

Presentation Guidelines-IAMBEST 2023 (Online)

Specifications for Online Oral Presentation

1. Presenters must present with a power-point presentation.
2. The presentation with a VDO recording must be saved as a backup file in MPEG-4 Video (.mp4) format, which shows the presenter's face at the bottom right corner without obstructing the content of the presentation.
3. Make sure the voice record is loud and clear throughout the presentation without music playing or any unnecessary disturbances.
4. The allotted time for oral presentation should be 10 minutes.
5. Right after each presentation ends, there will be a 5 minutes online question session

6. The upload of the recorded presentation is accepted until 19 May 2023.

Specifications for Online Poster Presentation

1. Presenters must present with a power-point presentation.
2. Please submit a poster of A0 size saved in JPEG (*.jpg) format
3. The presentation with a VDO recording must be saved as a backup file in MPEG-4 Video (.mp4) format, which shows the presenter's face at the bottom right corner without obstructing the content of the presentation.
4. Make sure the voice record is loud and clear throughout the presentation without music playing or any unnecessary disturbances.
5. The allotted time for oral presentation should be 5 minutes.
6. Right after each presentation ends, there will be a 5 minutes online question session

Presentation Guidelines-IAMBEST 2023 (On-site)

Specifications for Oral Presentation

1. During a presentation, a total of 15 minutes must be allocated, including 10 minutes for presenting and 5 minutes for a question session.

- When the presenter has reached a seven-minute presentation, the first-time notice will be displayed.

- Following the completion of the 10-minute presentation, the second-time notice will be displayed that the presenters are required to end and prepare for the question session.

2. The presentation file must be saved on the computer at your presentation venue which is between

8.00 and 8.30 and 12.20 and 12.45.

The presentation order may be altered if the presenter failed to save a file on the computer during the aforementioned period as determined by the chairman, in order to make the presentation run smoothly and efficiently as planned.

Specifications for Poster Presentation

1. A recommended poster size is 90 cm. by 120 cm. with one side

2. Each poster presentation will be 10 minutes including a question session.

The designated poster presenter (author or coauthor) must be present at the assigned space during the designated time to discuss the work presented.

Remarks: The award will be considered for both oral and poster presentations.
